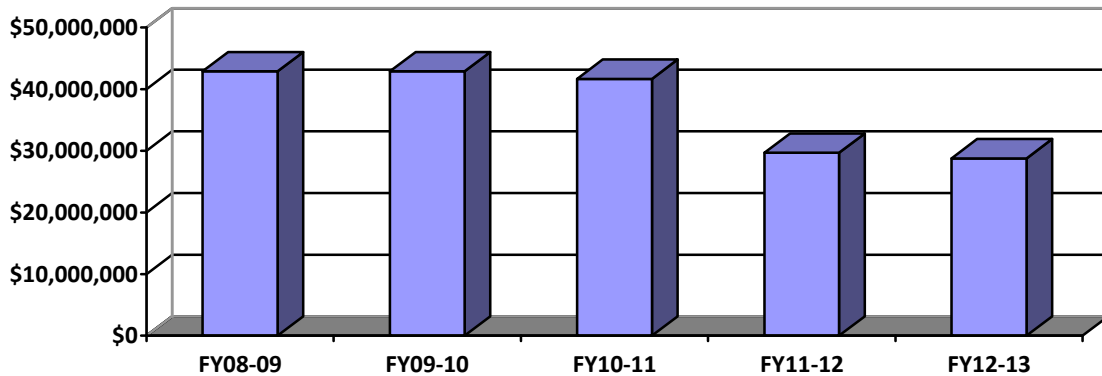

Additionally, Creighton also received nearly \$4 million in congressional earmarks from September 1, 2009 to June 30, 2011.
