## LB595 Cancer & Smoking Disease Research Program AWARD TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- 1) Rebudgeting between individual cost categories is allowed, provided the cumulative result of such transfers does not exceed ten percent (10%) of the annual budget.
  - a) Any transfers that would cumulatively result in more than ten percent (10%) of the annual budget MUST have PRIOR written approval from DHHS.
    - Requests must be submitted in writing or electronically to Sponsored Programs Administration prior to the change occurring. Change requests must:
      - (a) Include an explanation of why the change is needed
      - (b) Follow the original parameters of the original proposal guidelines
      - (c) Include revised budget worksheet(s) and budget justification(s)
  - Rebudgeting requests become effective when written or electronic approval is received from DHHS.
- 2) Carryforward from one budget period to the next budget period is NOT allowed
- 3) Annual written progress report and presentation at the External Advisory Committee (EAC) annual site visit required.
  - a) Sponsored Programs Administration will provide guidelines for the written annual progress report and presentation format.
  - b) EAC annual site visit is typically in late August of each year
- 4) Include the following funding source/disclaimer language on all publications supported by funds awarded under Neb. Rev. Stat. § 81-638 (2) (3):

This (publication/journal article/etc.) is supported by revenue from Nebraska's excise tax on cigarettes awarded to (name of principal investigator, name of institution) through the Nebraska Department of Health & Human Services (DHHS). Its contents represent the view(s) of the author(s) and do not necessarily represent the official views of the State of Nebraska or DHHS
