TITLE: iEdison

DESCRIPTION

iEdison (which stands for Interagency Edison) helps government grantees and contractors comply with the Bayh-Dole Act. Bayh-Dole regulations require that government-funded inventions be reported to the federal agency that made the award. iEdison provides a single interface for grantees and contractors to interact with any participating agency.

RESPONSIBILITY

In coordination with the Creighton University Intellectual Resources Management (IRM) office, the Principal Investigator is responsible for reporting to the iEdison system inventions resulting from a Federal award. IRM will notify Sponsored Programs Administration of any investigators reporting inventions that were a result of Federal funding.
