Consider Sustainability

Every year student organizations and campus divisions and departments participate in hundreds of tabling events on campus. The **Sustainable Creighton Green Tabling Guide** is a resource to help groups incorporate sustainable practices into tabling events.

Why We Care

Caring for our common home is part of Creighton's Catholic, Jesuit identity and mission. Working to make tabling events more sustainable is one way to care for creation. Every action matters. **Local acts, global impacts.**

- Advertise your tabling event through social media, *Creighton Today*, *CUInvolved*, and email instead of paper fliers.
- Make sure you have a sturdy container to keep all of your tabling supplies together and to keep items from getting smashed and wasted before tabling begins.
- Utilize technology instead of paper for sign-ups.
- Instead of handing out brochures to everyone who visits your table, utilize a QR code directing people to resources.
- Utilize double-sided, B/W printing for any unavoidable printing.
- Avoid handing out individually wrapped candy and treats.
- Only provide giveaways that are sustainable and useful or skip giveaways altogether. Visit the <u>Sustainable Creighton Swag Guide</u> for tips!
- Decorate your table with a bright, reusable tablecloth and other durable and reusable items to draw attention to your table. Avoid balloons!
- When tabling outside be prepared for wind! Make sure to have some heavy items or small stones to hold down your materials so that they do not blow away and create litter.
