# Further Development of the Pediatric Rehabilitation Intervention Measure of Engagement – PRIME-G







## WHAT ARE WE STUDYING?

The purpose of this study is to make sure that a questionnaire called The Pediatric Rehabilitation Measure of Engagement—General version (PRIME-G) works.

## WHO CAN BE IN THIS STUDY?

This study will include parents and adult caregivers with children who will be receiving outpatient therapy services (physical, occupational, or speech) for a period of time.

# WHAT WILL PARTICIPATION IN THIS STUDY INVOLVE?

Total participation time in this study is expected to be 20 minutes. Participants would be asked to complete the PRIME-G survey 3 times – at the start, middle, and end of their child's anticipated therapy plan of care.

### **ARE THERE ANY RISKS?**

Participants may experience tiredness, annoyance, frustration, or feelings of inconvenience when completing PRIME-G.
